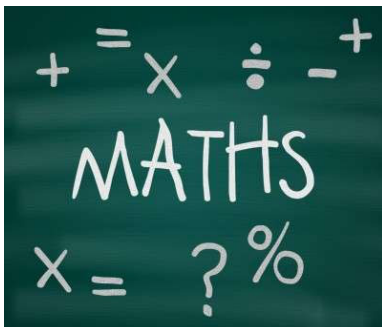
## Cricket
