Free Sport Shirts for 2021

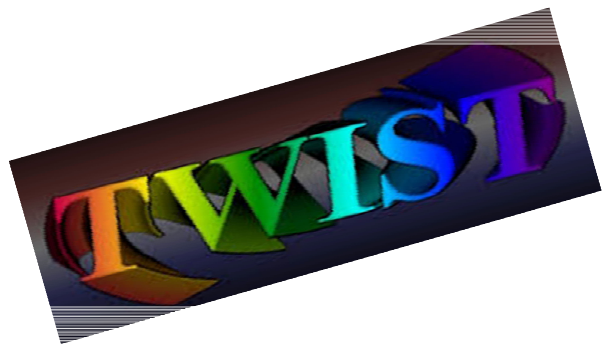
