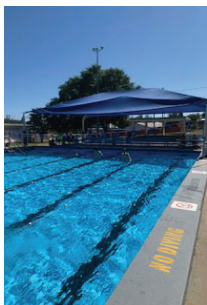
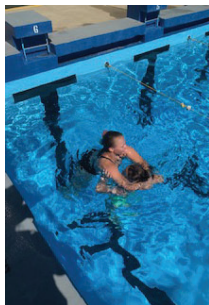
## Bandlink Narrabri

Last week Alexander Waller performed in a concert band of 130 musicians. He participated in rehearsals and tutorials in preparation for the two concerts performed over a three day workshop.



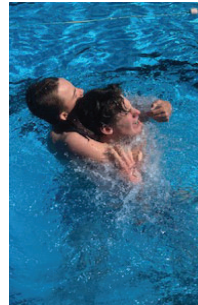
## Christmas Carols

Well done to the members of the Gwydir band who performed carols at the Warialda Rail Christmas party last Saturday night.



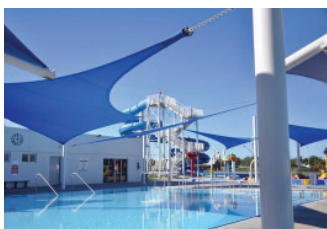
## Life saving
