Netball



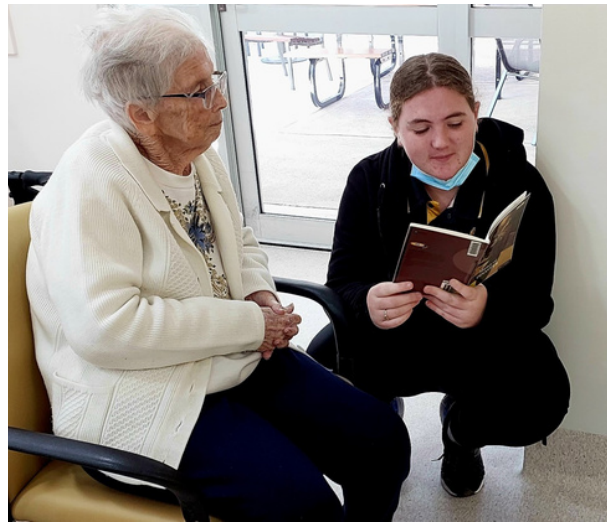
